the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, do hereby remise, release, bargain, sell and convey, and forever quit-claim unto the said Doctors Office Building, Inc., its successors

An easement to lay, maintain, replace and repair a sewer line with appurtenances thereto through, over, along and under a parcel of land thirty (30) feet in width situated in Waterville in the County of Kennebec and State of Maine, the center line of which parcel is more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the westerly line of premises owned by the within Grantee, Doctors Office Building Inc., in the southwest corner of premises owned by the within Grantors; thence in a straight line and in a general northeasterly direction to Manhole No. 22 as delineated upon a plan of Waterville Sewerage District Easements made by Ralph Cullen dated February 15, 1972.

It is agreed that there will be no building or other structures hereinafter erected within the limits of the above described easement.

Meaning and intending hereby to convey an easement to maintain the aforesaid sewer line upon a portion of the premises acquired by the within Grantors by deed of Elsmore Penney dated March 29, 1968 and recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Book 1469, Page 426.

ICorp. hereby joins in this conveyance for the sole purpose of subordinating a mortgage from Bruce Trembley and Adele Trembley to ICORP. recorded in the Kennebec County Registry of Deeds to the within sewerage easement granted to Doctors Office Building Inc.




